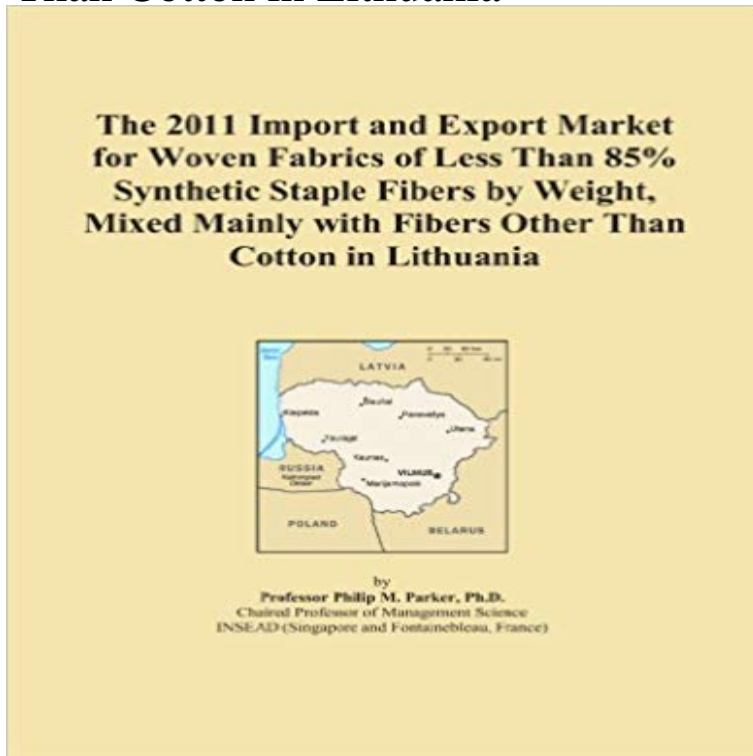


The 2011 Import and Export Market for Woven Fabrics of Less Than 85% Synthetic Staple Fibers by Weight, Mixed Mainly with Fibers Other Than Cotton in Lithuania



On the demand side, exporters and strategic planners focusing on woven fabrics of less than 85% synthetic staple fibers by weight, mixed mainly with fibers other than cotton in Lithuania face a number of questions. Which countries are supplying woven fabrics of less than 85% synthetic staple fibers by weight, mixed mainly with fibers other than cotton to Lithuania? How important is Lithuania compared to others in terms of the entire global and regional market? How much do the imports of woven fabrics of less than 85% synthetic staple fibers by weight, mixed mainly with fibers other than cotton vary from one country of origin to another in Lithuania? On the supply side, Lithuania also exports woven fabrics of less than 85% synthetic staple fibers by weight, mixed mainly with fibers other than cotton. Which countries receive the most exports from Lithuania? How are these exports concentrated across buyers? What is the value of these exports and which countries are the largest buyers? This report was created for strategic planners, international marketing executives and import/export managers who are concerned with the market for woven fabrics of less than 85% synthetic staple fibers by weight, mixed mainly with fibers other than cotton in Lithuania. With the globalization of this market, managers can no longer be contented with a local view. Nor can managers be contented with out-of-date statistics which appear several years after the fact. I have developed a methodology, based on macroeconomic and trade models, to estimate the market for woven fabrics of less than 85% synthetic staple fibers by weight, mixed mainly with fibers other than cotton for those countries serving Lithuania via exports, or supplying from Lithuania via imports. It does so for the current year based on a variety of key historical indicators and econometric models. In what follows, Chapter 2 begins
