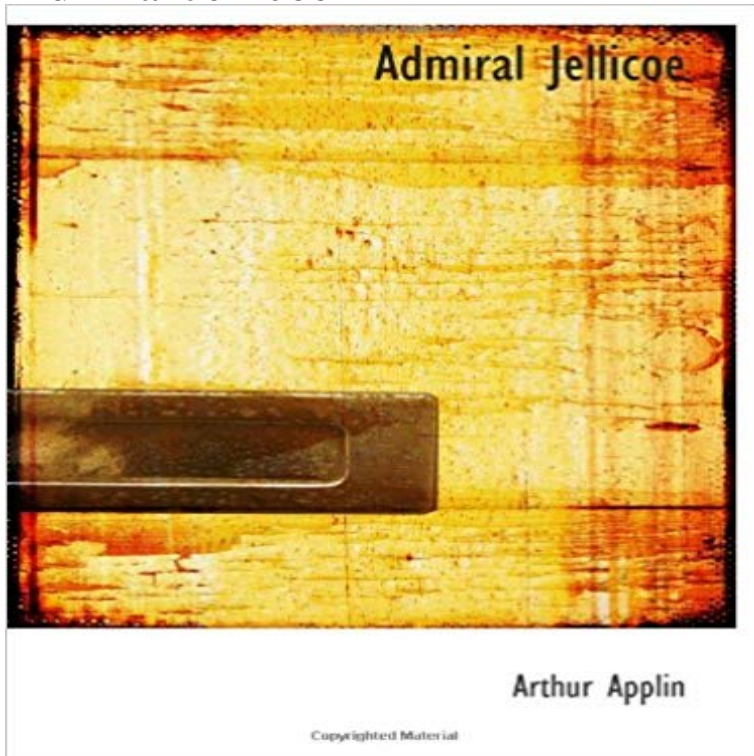


Admiral Jellicoe
