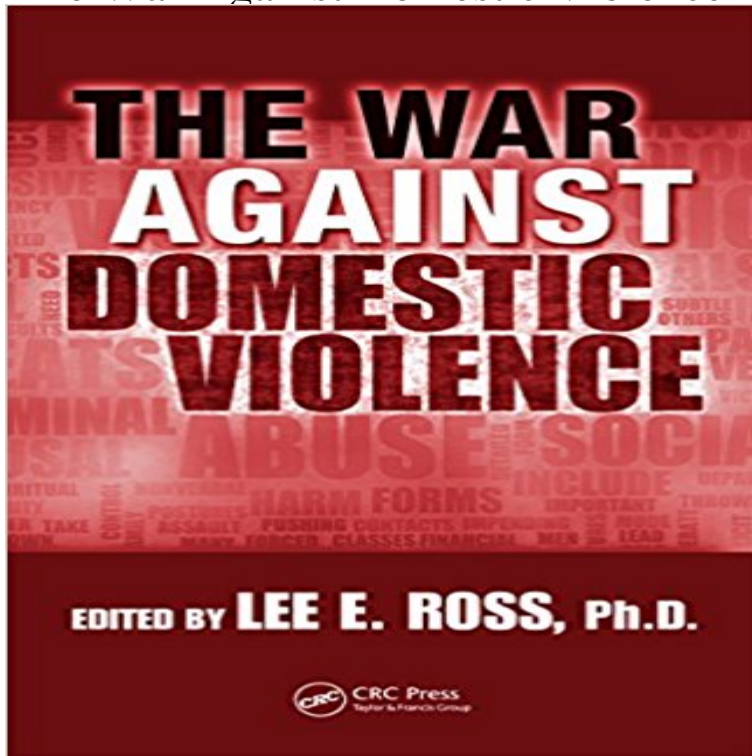


The War Against Domestic Violence
