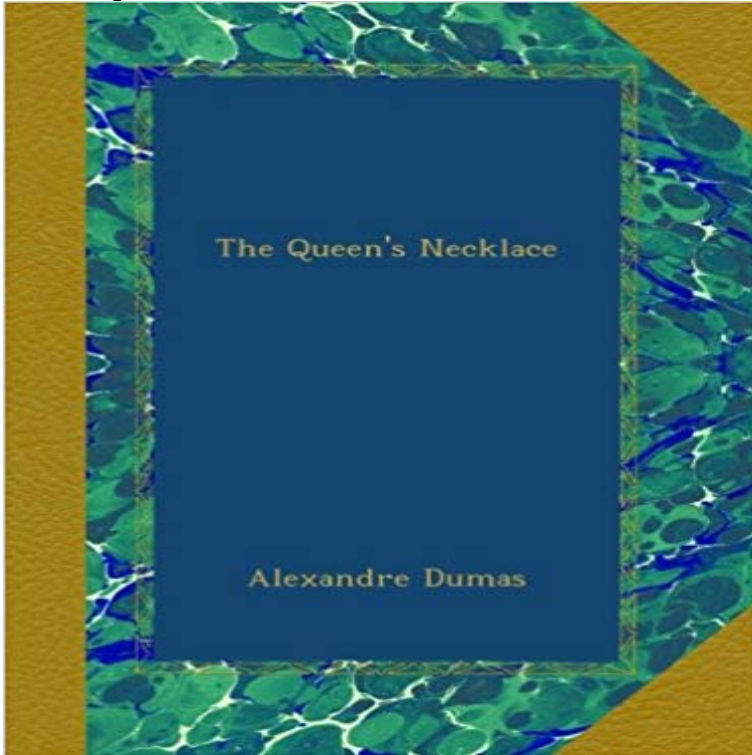


The Queens Necklace
