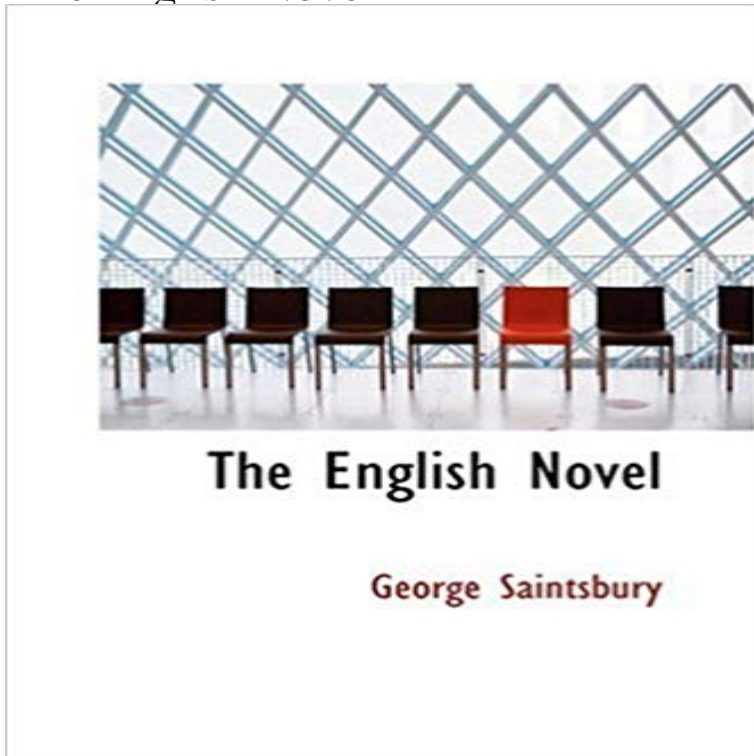


The English Novel
