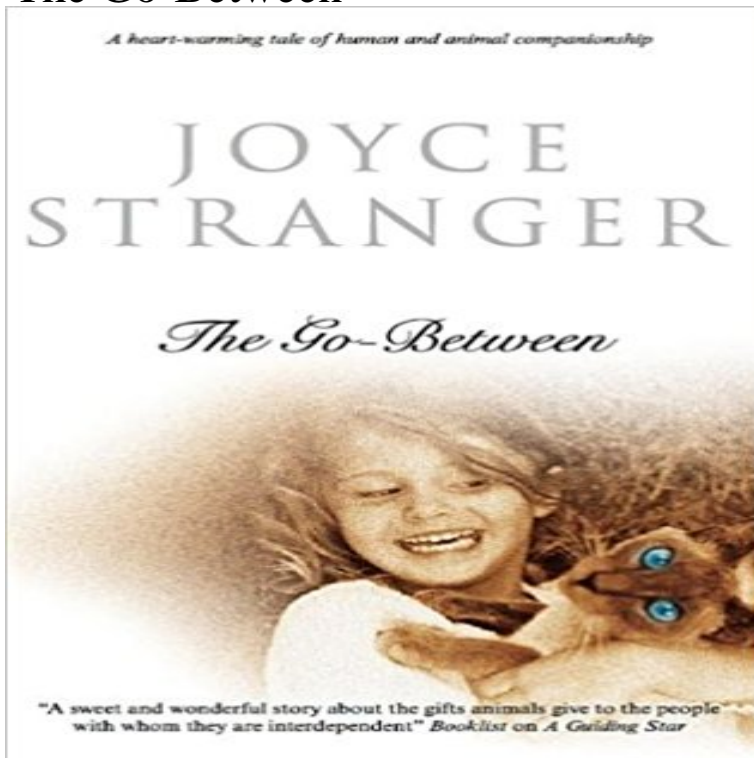


The Go-Between
