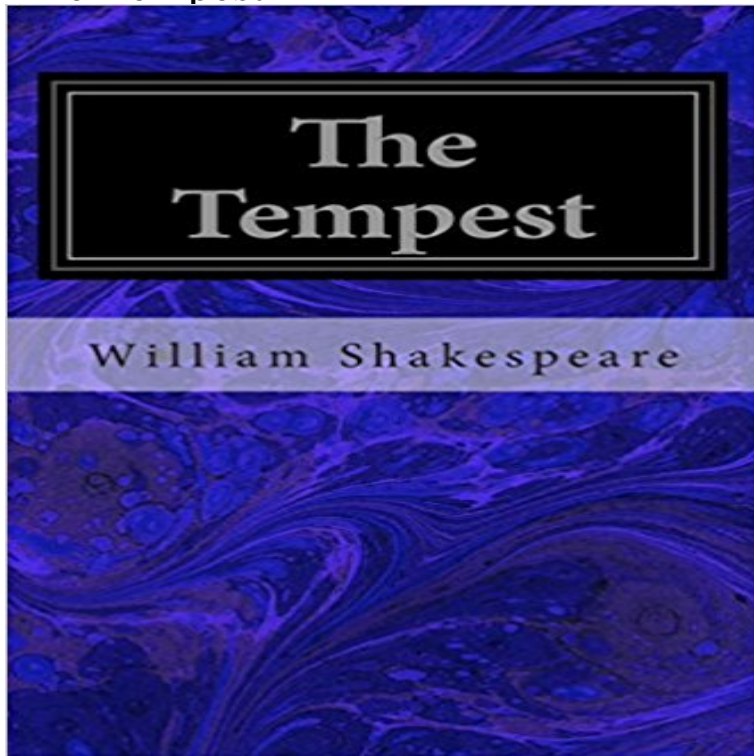


# The Tempest
