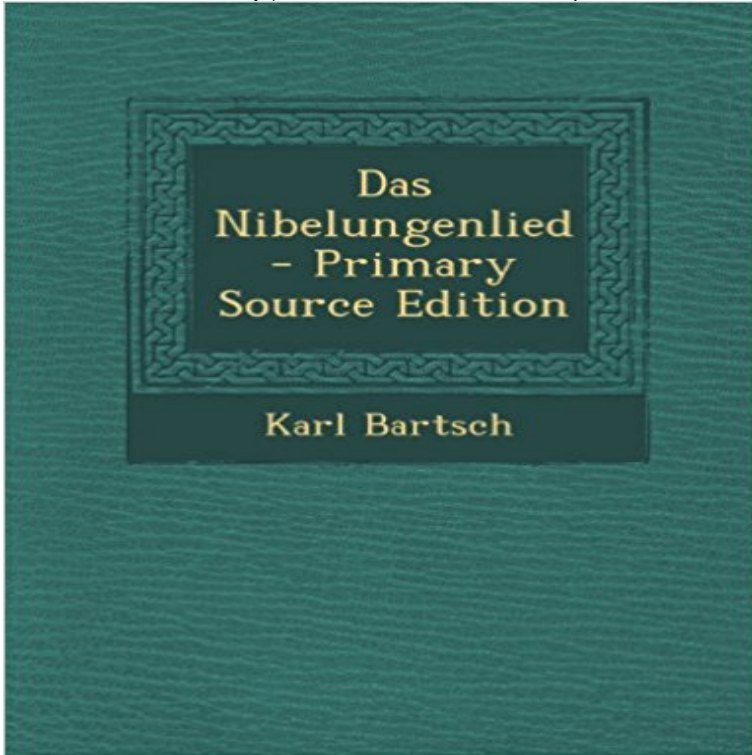


Das Nibelungenlied - Primary Source Edition (German Edition)
