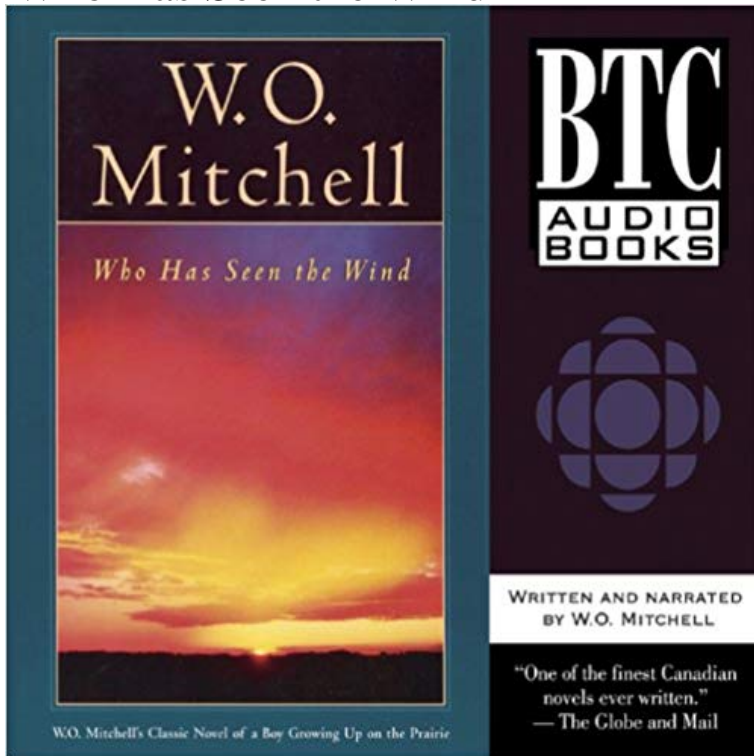


Who Has Seen the Wind
