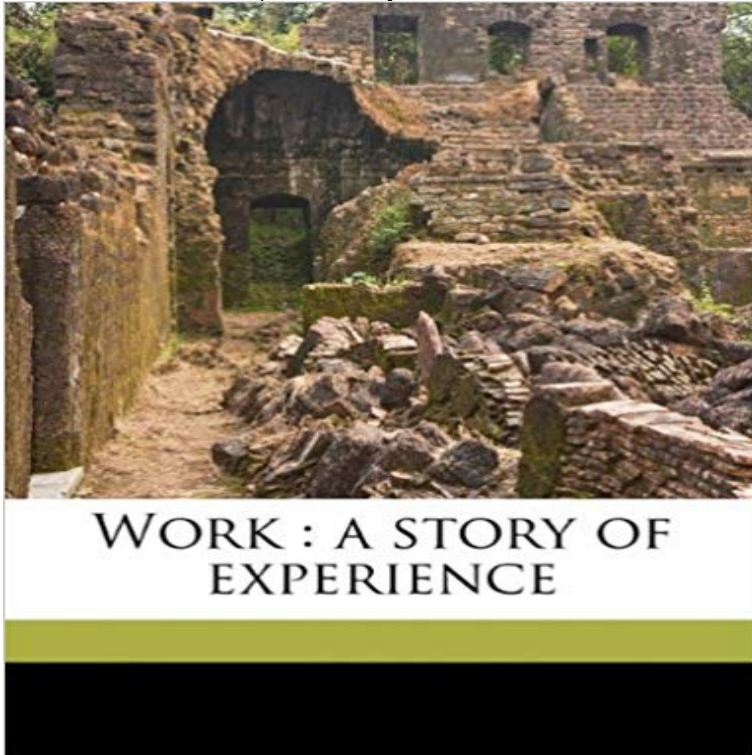


Work: a story of experience
